Sub: Appointment on compassionate grounds -
adopted sons/daughters.

Attention is invited to Board's letter No. E(NG)II/78/RC-1/1 dated 30.4.1979 wherein it has been laid down that for the purpose of compassionate appointment, the definition of dependents will be the same as in the Pass Rules.

2. On a question whether adopted sons/daughters are eligible to be considered for compassionate appointment, Board had decided vide letter No. E(NG)II/86/RC-1/1 Policy dated 20.5.1988 that an adopted son/adopted daughter will also be eligible to be considered for appointment on compassionate grounds (in the circumstances in which such compassionate appointment is permissible) in case the conditions given therein are satisfied.

3. The matter has been reviewed by Board and it has been decided that adopted sons/daughters can be considered for compassionate appointment provided such adoption has been accepted for the issue of privilege pass/PTOs as per provisions under the Pass Rules.
