Sub: Appointment in Railway service to the next of kin of persons died in the Terrorist attack at CST, Mumbai on 26.11.2008.

Pursuant to the announcement made by Hon'ble Minister for Railways on 2.12.2008, the issue of providing employment on the Railways to the wards/legal heirs of those killed during the terrorist attack at CST, Mumbai on 26.11.2008, has been under consideration of this Ministry.

2. It has now been decided that wards or legal heirs of those who have died in the said incident may be considered for engagement as fresh face Substitute in Group 'D' under General Manager's discretionary powers subject to fulfilment of the extant instructions.
3. Each application received for appointment may be scrutinized individually and after being fully satisfied about the dependence of the applicant on the deceased person as well as after scrutiny of eligibility conditions for the job, the candidate may be engaged as fresh face Substitute in Group 'D'.

4. Further, it has also been decided that General Manager may relax the upper age limit as well as educational qualification on case-to-case basis for appointment in the incident ibid. Further, in case of the applicant being totally unsuitable for Railway jobs, General Managers may probe the possibility of another applicant who is equally suitable for the purpose of giving livelihood to the family and dependents of the deceased.
